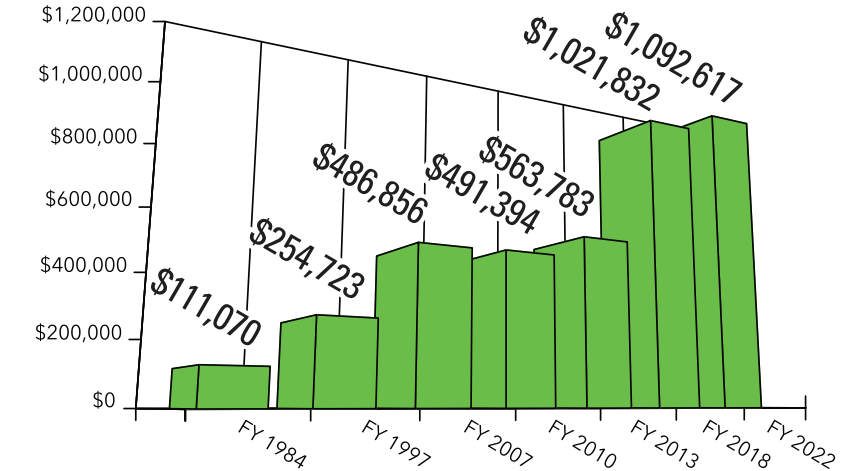

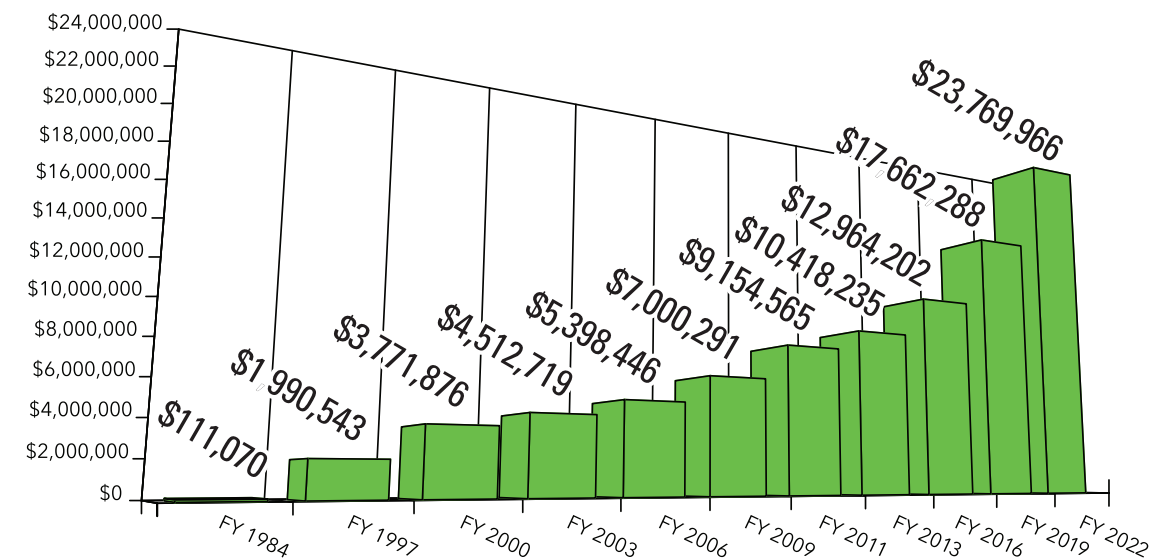
Annual Report

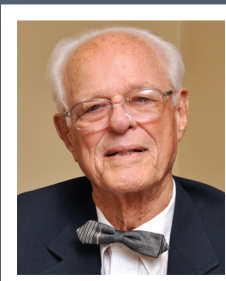

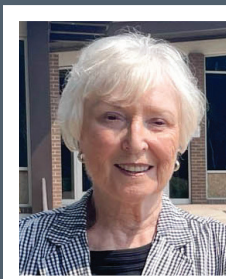

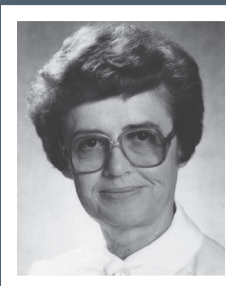

Leaving a LEGACY

An Investment in our Community

Your support now and in the future will help to continue the College's mission and dedication to our community. The following represents sample language that is commonly used to make a gift by will:

- A fixed amount of money or a designated property: Individuals often include a provision in their wills for the Allegany College of Maryland Foundation to receive stated sums of money. One example of such a specific bequest would be, "I hereby give and bequeath the sum of \$_____ to the Allegany College of Maryland Foundation, Inc., Cumberland, Maryland, for its general uses and purposes."
- A percentage of the estate: Individuals often include a provision in their wills for the Allegany College of Maryland Foundation to receive a stated percentage of their estate. One example of such a bequest would be, "I hereby give and bequeath ___ percent of my total estate to the Allegany College of Maryland Foundation, Inc., Cumberland, Maryland."
- A residual bequest: "I give all the residue of my estate, including real and personal property, to the Allegany College of Maryland Foundation, Inc., Cumberland, Maryland."

The Foundation generally advises donors to describe the purposes of their gifts as broadly as possible and to avoid detailed limitations and restrictions. We encourage you to work closely with your legal, tax, and financial advisors when creating a will or estate plan. Scholarship Program Overview: The Allegany County Commissioners understand the impact of Allegany College of Maryland and the education and job training provided to the community. 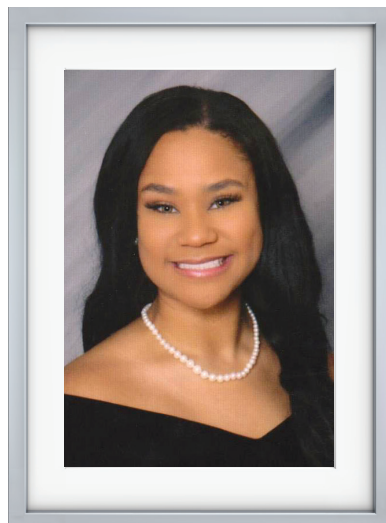

Economic Impact OVERVIEW FACT SHEET

Allegany College of Maryland plays a significant role in the local economy and is a sound investment from multiple perspectives. Students benefit from improved lifestyles and increased earnings. Taxpayers benefit from a larger economy and lower social costs. Finally, the community as a whole benefits from increased job and investment opportunities, higher business revenues, greater availability of public funds, and an eased tax burden.

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS

Student Perspective

- The average ACM student’s income increases by \$3.70 for every dollar invested in ACM.
- Students enjoy an attractive 22.9% average rate of return on their ACM educational investment.

Taxpayer Perspective

- Taxpayers gain \$13.6 million in added tax revenue and public sector savings.
- For every dollar of this support, taxpayers see a return of \$2.60 (in the form of higher tax receipts and avoided costs).
- State and local governments see an annual rate of return of 4.8% on their support for ACM.

Other Impact

- ACM Alumni currently employed in the regional workforce amounted to \$77.3 million in added income.
- ACM added \$106.7 million in income to the ACM Service Area economy.
- 1 out of every 30 jobs in the ACM Service Area is supported by the activities of ACM and its students.
