ACM Credit Course Registration - Frequently Asked Questions

Are you offering any face to face classes for summer?

ACM's online summer registration begins Monday, April 20th. On our course schedule, you may notice that there are multiple classroom offerings listed for late June and July. Please, be aware that although these sections are listed, there is the possibility that the Stay- At-Home order will not yet be lifted in the state of Maryland. In this case, the sections will be either postponed, canceled, or reformatted to online instruction. Should I schedule for a placement exam?

Allegany College of Maryland uses a number of measurements to appropriately place entering students into classes that meet their individual academic needs and goals. One of these measurements is the Accuplacer, a nationally recognized placement test developed by the College Board.

While stay-at-home orders remain in effect, ACM will not administer the Accuplacer. Instead, advisors will work with students individually, using a number of other indicators (current HS GPA, HS courses, early college credit, PARCC/SAT/ACT, etc.) to determine appropriate placement.

What should I know about enrolling in a course to transfer back to my home institution?

While ACM advisors will make every effort to ensure the transferability of courses, it is the receiving institution (*the school that you are transferring courses/credits to*) that makes the final determination. It is your responsibility to contact an admissions/advising representative at the receiving institution to confirm course transferability in your particular program (major).
