\*Depending on the student's selection to complete the "Literature" and "Literature/Humanities/Fine Arts" requirement(s), the course may satisfy one of the identified programmatic requirements. Students are encouraged to consult with advisors within the WVU English Department or the Eberly College Undergraduate Affairs Office. Any completed requirements would be replaced by General Elective hours to meet

Students completing degrees from the WVU Eberly College of Arts and Sciences are encouraged to work with their advisors to integrate completion of an academic minor or minors into their programs of study. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills. Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.


