Students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.25 or higher to be admitted to the Reed College of Media upon transferring to West Virginia University. Students who do not have a GPA of at least 2.25 must have a GPA of 2.0 and a C or better in JRN 101 (WVU JRL 215) to be directly admitted to the Reed College.

* Students pursuing a degree in the Reed College of Media are required to complete one year (2 semesters) of a foreign language. Allegheny students can fulfill this requirement with the successful completion of SPAN 103 & 104. Students who wish to study a different language may forgo this required sequence and utilize ELECTIVE credit at WVU to fulfill this requirement.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.

Students completing a degree in the Reed College of Media are required to work with their advisors to integrate completion of an academic minor into their program of study. WVU offers over 100 minors that complement major fields of study, build on students' unique interests, expand perspectives, and broaden skills. Allegheny students may begin completion of certain minors at ACM by utilizing ELECTIVE hours to take courses equivalent to the minor's introductory requirements at WVU.
