## ADVANCING EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE THROUGH COMMUNITY SUPPORT

The Bedford County Regional Education Foundation expresses its sincere appreciation to the Everett Area Fund for awarding a \$2,000 grant in support of instructional equipment for the Nursing Simulation and Computer Technology laboratories at the ACM Bedford County Campus.



This generous funding will enable the purchase of a third 30-inch simulated nursing headwall, providing nursing students with enhanced opportunities for experiential learning as they develop critical skills in the use of oxygen and air flow meters, humidifiers, nasal cannulas, and suction collection systems.

In addition, new computer technology equipment—including a server, access points, firewall, switches, and cables—will establish a permanent private network to support simulated learning experiences. Together, these investments will significantly enhance the quality of hands-on laboratory instruction for students in both nursing and computer technology programs.
