2022-2023 Edward T. and Mary A. Conroy & Jean B. Cryor Memorial Scholarship

The Edward T. and Mary A. Conroy & Jean B. Cryor Memorial Scholarship is designed to provide financial assistance to the following groups:

- the son, daughter, stepchild, or the surviving spouse (who has not remarried) of a member of the United States Armed Forces who died as a result of military service or who suffered a service-connected 100% permanent disability as result of military service.
- a veteran who suffers a service-connected disability of 25% or greater, as a result of military service, and has exhausted or is no longer eligible for federal veterans' educational benefits.
- the son, daughter, stepchild, or surviving spouse of a victim of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks who died as a result of the attacks on the World Trade Center in New York City, the attack on the Pentagon in Virginia, or the crash of United Airlines Flight 93 in Pennsylvania.
- a POW/MIA of the Vietnam Conflict or his/her son, daughter, or stepchild and was a resident of this State at the time the person was declared to be a prisoner of war or missing in action.
- the son, daughter, stepchild, or surviving spouse (who has not remarried) of a state or local public safety employee or volunteer who died in the line of duty or who was 100 percent disabled in the line of duty; or a state or local public safety employee or volunteer who was 100 percent disabled in the line of duty.
- the son, daughter, stepchild, or surviving spouse (who has not remarried) of a school employee who, as a result of an act of violence either died in the line of duty or sustained an injury in the line of duty that rendered the school employee 100% disabled.

To be considered for this scholarship at Allegany College of MD students must:

- Submit all application materials by **July 15, 2022**.
- Be a MD resident (with the exception of children of a State or local public safety employee who died in the line of duty).
- Be enrolled for a minimum of 6 credits each semester.
