The Allegany College of Maryland President finalists are (in alphabetical order):

Kurt Hoffman, Ed.D., is the Senior Vice President of Instructional and Student Affairs at Allegany College of Maryland. Previously, Dr. Hoffman served as the Chair of the Division of Social and Behavioral Sciences at Allegany College of Maryland. He earned a Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership from Frostburg State University, a master's degree in Psychology from Sonoma State University, a bachelor's degree in Psychology from Arizona State University, and an associate's degree in Arts from Scottsdale Community College.

David Jones is the Vice President of Advancement and Community Relations and the Executive Director of the ACM Foundation at Allegany College of Maryland. Previously, Mr. Jones served as an Education Program Specialist at the United States Department of Education. He earned a master's degree in Education from Frostburg State University, and a bachelor's degree in Social Science from Frostburg State University.

Kristin Mallory, Ed.D., is the Vice President for Academic Affairs at Wor-Wic Community College in Maryland. Previously, Dr. Mallory served as the Provost of BridgeValley Community and Technical College in West Virginia. She earned a Doctor of Education from Marshall University, a master's degree in Education from Salisbury State University, a bachelor's degree in Dental Hygiene from West Liberty State College, and an associate's degree in Dental Hygiene from West Liberty State College.

Thomas Striplin, Ed.D., is the President of Eastern West Virginia Community and Technical College in West Virginia. Previously, Dr. Striplin served as the Dean of Arts & Sciences at Allegany College of Maryland. He earned a Doctor of Education in Educational Leadership from Frostburg State University, a master's degree in Education from Frostburg State University, a bachelor's degree in Respiratory Therapy from Salisbury State University, and an associate's degree in Applied Science in Respiratory Therapy from Hudson Valley Community College.
