As the new year begins, please remain careful and diligent. Continue to do your part following the critical prevention strategies: **Wear** your mask, **Watch** your distance, and **Wash** your hands.

COVID-19 standards to be followed:

- 1. Remember that *everyone* is required to wear a face covering, observe social distancing, maintain hand hygiene, avoid gatherings, follow directional signage, and otherwise limit exposure/transmission risk to yourself and others.
- 2. All students and employees are required to self-monitor for symptoms of illness and to sign an attestation before going to class or reporting to work that you are symptom-free, have not been exposed to COVID-19, and are in compliance with <u>Governor Hogan's travel guidance</u>.
 - Individuals who do travel to Maryland must either <u>obtain a negative COVID-19 test result</u> or self-quarantine for 10 days. This travel applies to all states, with the exception of Delaware, Pennsylvania, Virginia, West Virginia, and Washington, DC.
- 3. Stay home if you are sick or are under an isolation/quarantine order. Get tested if you have COVID-19 symptoms. If you have tested positive, if you have been identified by public health officials as a close contact of someone who has tested positive, or if you have been exposed to the virus, we need to know and ask that you contact a member of ACM's COVID-19 Command Team for guidance: https://www.allegany.edu/coronavirus/documents/COVID-19 Exposure Procedures.pdf
- 4. ACM will continue to operate under special protocols in an effort to protect our students, staff, faculty, and community. Offices are open with modified staffing/operations and many ACM employees are working remotely. Virtual appointments are encouraged.
