APPLY FOR RELIEF

The pandemic has been incredibly tough for college students, but additional financial help is available. Please apply for **COVID-19 relief funds** using this <u>quick online application</u> if you've registered for spring 2022 classes.

- You're eligible if you (or a family member) has experienced a pandemic-related hardship loss
 of employment, food insecurity, housing disruption, lack of course materials, loss of health care,
 loss of child care, caring for sick family member, and other financial difficulties.
- It's a **grant** for you to use, not a loan that you repay.
- You can apply for a maximum of \$1,000.
- The sooner you apply, the better your chances of receiving a HEERF award.

PLAN AHEAD

I know it's hard to think about next week let alone next semester or next year. But staying on track academically matters and I promise that your future self will thank you.

- Register now for your spring semester to get the in-person and online class you want.
- Check in with an <u>advising specialist</u> or your program coordinator if you have questions.
- Complete your 2022-23 FAFSA.
- Apply for scholarships using the <u>2022-23 scholarship application</u>. You can use the <u>RAWC</u> for assistance with your scholarship essay.
- Work with a <u>transfer advisor</u> to set up or adjust your transfer plan if you're pursuing your bachelors.
