Stay Informed - President's Advisory Team (PAT): The President's Advisory Team (PAT) meets monthly to 1) provide advice and counsel to the President regarding the overall operation of the College; 2) assist the President in developing the College calendar; 3) collaborate with the President on creating and implementing strategic plans for the College; 4) recommend funding patterns and priorities to the President; and 5) develop the agenda for All-College Assembly staff meetings. The next meeting is scheduled for May 2nd, starting at 1 pm. Budget Update: The preliminary FY26 budget for Allegany County Government was presented last night, which includes flat funding for ACM. This was our request (good news) and would allow ACM to receive the increase in funding from the State of Maryland. A second budget hearing is scheduled for May 15th, with the final budget expected to be adopted on May 29th. Although not final until later this month, this budget would ensure that ACM can address the education and workforce needs of our community, provide key services to our students, and ensure that we recognize and support the dedicated efforts of our faculty/staff. This has been a challenging year financially at the County and State levels, and I am grateful to our elected officials and government partners for recognizing the importance of ACM.

<u>Athletics:</u> Congratulations to our faculty and staff colleagues in athletics for hosting a banquet earlier this week to honor and recognize our student athletes for 2024-2025. It was a special evening to celebrate the success of our student athletes, as well as to listen to the challenge and encouragement provided by keynote speaker Casey Roberts. A special thanks to Tommie Reams, April Higson, Courtney Eagan, John Bone, and Metz Culinary for the exceptional planning of the event (and the tasty meal). Well done, <u>ACM athletics</u>.
