David Jones, executive director of ACM foundation, will be leaving ACM. Gene Hall will send a letter of congratulations on his new position at FSU and thanking him for his help in establishing the ACMRA scholarship.

An "In Memoriam" link will be placed on the ACMRA website. There will be a photo of the deceased, title at time of retirement, and years of service at ACM. Joyce will contact Human Resources for years of service.

Lifetime membership for ACMRA, which was suggested by Jim Williams, will be investigated further before a decision can be made.

A list of charter members will be posted on the ACMRA website. Joyce will compile the list and send it to Nick Taylor.

Patty Andrews suggested that mugs for the Retirees Association could be designed for purchase. She will check into this possibility.
