

**Articulation Agreement between  
Allegany College of Maryland and Mount Aloysius College  
February 17, 2016**

Allegany College of Maryland and Mount Aloysius College hereby establish an agreement allowing Allegany College of Maryland students to transfer to Mount Aloysius College according to the following provisions:

1. Mount Aloysius College will accept Allegany College of Maryland students who have completed an Associate Degree in the following majors and have achieved a cumulative grade point average of not less than 2.0 (in a 4.0 system) as calculated by Allegany College of Maryland.

These Allegany College of Maryland students are eligible to transfer into one of the following baccalaureate programs, offered by Mount Aloysius College, that correspond to their major at Allegany College of Maryland:

Other baccalaureate programs will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

2. Mount Aloysius College will accept credits earned by students from Allegany College of Maryland into an Associate or Bachelor degree program on a course by course analysis. In order to transfer any course, the course must be completed with a "C" or higher and not be developmental or remedial in nature.
3. Mount Aloysius College and Allegany College of Maryland will work collaboratively to monitor the academic performance of students enrolling under this agreement. Department chairs of each program will monitor academic performance, identify concerns, and work cooperatively with Admissions to ensure a seamless transfer into Mount Aloysius College.

4. Allegany College of Maryland and Mount Aloysius College agree to publicize this agreement among students, faculty, staff and administration.
5. This articulation agreement may be terminated by either party after a ninety-day written notification of the other party.
