## TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Coppin State University determines transfer admission based upon the following criteria:

- A. Fewer than 25 credits** (as determined by Coppin) must meet the following:
1. Cumulative GPA must be a minimum of 2.50. Students between 2.00 and 2.49 will be considered based on high school grades and SAT or ACT scores.
  2. Official copies of your final high school transcript.
  - 3.. Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended must be sent to Coppin's Admissions Office.

**B. 25 or more credits** (as determined by Coppin) must meet the following:

1. Cumulative GPA must be a minimum of 2.00
2. Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended must be sent to Coppin's Admissions Office.

Admissions priority will be granted to graduates of Maryland community and junior colleges and to those community college students who have earned at least 56 transferable credits but have not earned an Associate of Arts degree.

## MAXIMUM TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

**No more than 70 credits normally may be accepted for transfer credit from two-year or community colleges. The Coppin Admissions Office will select up to 70 credits that best fit the student's major.**

## SELECTION OF TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

Allegany College of Maryland works closely with Coppin State University to advise students in the selection of courses for transfer. Refer to the following resources for information:
