TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Edinboro University (EU) determines transfer admission based upon the following criteria:

Edinboro University considers any student who has complete one full-time semester after graduating from high school as a transfer student. Students must be in good academic (GPA of 2.0) and social standing to be considered for admission. All students are required to submit high school transcripts and test scores.

MAXIMUM TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

The maximum number of credits transferable from a community college is 60. Only courses in which the student has earned a C or better will transfer.

SELECTION OF TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

1. For a list of known courses that transfer to EU go to tes.collegesource.com and scroll down to Allegany College of Maryland.
2. Check the Edinboro's academic catalog to obtain a complete list of courses required by each major or refer to their [website](#).
3. Consult with your advisor, the Student Success Center, or Bedford County Campus Student Services for course transferability information or appropriate courses for a major.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Edinboro offers rolling admission. Students applying for the Fall Semester should apply between September and March, but early application is recommended.
