### TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Fairmont State University determines transfer admission based upon the following criteria:

**A. Fewer than 24 credits** of transferable credits, as determined by FSU.

1. Cumulative GPA from all college transcripts must be a minimum of 2.0 (2.5 recommended) on a 4.0 scale.
2. Official transcripts from all colleges/ universities attended sent to FSU Admissions Office.
3. High school transcripts and SAT or ACT scores sent to FSU Admissions Office.
4. Immunization records - Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR) (if born after January 1, 1957)

**B. 24 or more transferable credits**, as determined by FSU.

1. Cumulative GPA must be a minimum of 2.0 (2.5 recommended).
2. Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended must be sent to FSU Admissions Office.
3. Immunization records - Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR) (if born after January 1, 1957)

### MAXIMUM TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

**No more than 72 credits may be accepted for transfer credit from two-year or community colleges.**

## **SELECTION OF TRANSFERABLE CREDITS**

Transfer advisors are available in Cumberland Campus Student Success Center and Bedford County Campus Student Services Offices.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Students applying for the Fall Semester should apply between September 15 and March 15 for priority processing. Students applying for the Spring Semester should apply between September 1 and November 1 for priority processing.
