Admission criteria vary among Howard University's schools and colleges. In general, a transfer student must transfer a minimum of 15 credit hours from a regionally accredited postsecondary institution, have earned a 2.5 cumulative grade point average, and have received a passing grade of C or better in both a college-level English and college-level math course. Additional credentials, such as a high school transcript and SAT scores, may be requested for admission.

Admission applications and all associated documents including one letter of recommendation from a college professor must be received no later than February 15 (for fall semester), November 1 (for spring semester), and April 1 (for summer session).

The maximum number of credits transferable from a community college is 65. Only courses in which the student has earned a C or better will transfer.
