### TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Liberty University determines transfer admission based upon the following criteria:

Transfer admissions requirements vary depending upon the student's age and the number of college credits completed. If a student is 21 years or younger with fewer than 60 credits, the student will need to submit college transcripts, high school transcripts, and SAT or ACT scores. Students who are 22 or older with fewer than 60 credits must submit college transcripts and high school transcripts. SAT/ACT scores are not required. For all students who have an AA Degree and/or are transferring 60 or more credits, only college transcripts are required. No high school transcripts or SAT/ACT scores are required.

### MAXIMUM TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

The maximum number of credits transferable from a community college depends upon the student's select major at Liberty. Only courses in which the student has earned a C or better will transfer.

### SELECTION OF TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

- Transfer advisors are available in Cumberland Campus Student Success Center and Bedford County Campus Student Services Offices.
- Generally credits for courses are accepted if Liberty has a similar discipline, department or school. If an equivalent is not parallel to a specific course taught at Liberty but is in an available department or school, it may be accepted as elective credit.

### SUGGESTED GENERAL EDUCATION COURSES

Although ACM does not have an articulation agreement with Liberty, students have been successfully transferring there. Students should verify their course selection with the Liberty Admissions Office. Students wishing to participate in early registration and applying for financial aid, scholarships and housing should apply earlier. For the Spring Semester, students should apply as early as possible, preferably before September 1.
