TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Salisbury University determines transfer admission based upon the following criteria:

A. Fewer than 24 credits of transferable credits, as determined by Salisbury.

1. Must meet SU's admissions requirements for freshmen.
2. Send official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended sent to SU Admissions Office.
3. Provide high school transcripts and SAT scores to the SU Admissions Office.
4. Contractual admissions is provided for students who have completed 12 to 23 credits and have an overall GPA of 2.5 or higher.

B. 24 or more transferable credits, as determined by Salisbury.

1. Cumulative GPA must be a minimum of 2.0.
2. Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended must be sent to SU Admissions Office.
3. Leave the previous college in good academic and disciplinary standing.

MAXIMUM TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

Up to 64 credits may be accepted for transfer credit from 2-year or community colleges.

SELECTION OF TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

Allegany College of Maryland works closely with Salisbury University to advise students in the selection of courses for transfer. Refer to the following resources for information:

- [ARTSYS](#), the Articulation System for Maryland Colleges and Universities, provides course equivalencies for most ACM courses and lists of Recommended Transfer Programs for transfer to Salisbury.
- Transfer advisors are available in Cumberland Campus Student Success Center and Bedford Student Services Office
- Salisbury University staff visit the Cumberland Campus annually.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students applying to Salisbury for the fall semester should apply between September 1 and March 1, while students applying for the spring semester should apply between September 1 and November 15. Please note that some programs have specific admissions requirements and application deadlines.

1. Complete an [online application](#) and pay the application fee is \$50. Phi Theta Kappa members may request the PTK fee waiver at the payment section of the application.
2. Submit a separate transcript from all colleges, community and four-year, you have attended, Once your official transcripts are received, an admission decision will be made,
3. Credit from all college or university attend must be sent on the original transcript of the college awarding the credits.
4. Transcripts must be sent officially the Office of Admissions. Faxed copies cannot be accepted. Transcripts are considered official only if sent directly from the institution through secure and accepted electronic delivery methods, U.S. mail, or hand delivered in a sealed envelope.

Complete <u>two</u> courses with laboratories from at least two areas: Biology 100, 101, 102, 103, 109, 121, 131, 145, 204, 207, 208, Chemistry 101, 102, 203, 204, Physics 101, 102, 105, 106, 130, 132, 201, 202 IVB. Complete <u>one</u> additional course (need not include a lab) from Group IVA or Computer Science or Mathematics (totaling at least 3 credit hours) from the following: Computer Technology 101, 190, 221, 234, Mathematics 102, 105, 109, 119, 120, 200, 201 IVC. Complete <u>one</u> math course for a total of three credit hours: Mathematics 102, 105, 109, 119, 120, 200, 201	
Group V Health Fitness- One Course	
Physical Education 145
