TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The University of Maryland, Baltimore is the professional branch of UM. Most of their programs require 90 credits or a bachelor's degree for admission; however, Dental Hygiene, Nursing, and Pharmacy programs accept students directly from community colleges. The Nursing Program has direct entry, as well as an RN to BSN option. Admission is competitive and students must have completed or be in the process of completing all admissions requirements before applying. Visit the webpages of your program of interest to determine the admissions requirements. Be aware that UMB does not offer any general education or prerequisite courses. All prerequisites must be met before applying.

Admission to professional health programs or law school does not require a specific major, but does require the completion of certain prerequisite courses plus acquisition of applicable skills and experiences. Students who plan to apply to programs that require additional courses not offered at ACM courses or a bachelor's degree should meet with an advisor to discuss the selection of a major that relates to the professional school prerequisites. Discussion should also center-around the selection of a four-year university and preparation for transfer to that school. Consult with your advisor, the ACM Advising Center, the Student Success Center, or Bedford County Campus Student Services for course transferability information or appropriate courses for a major.
