TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

UMUC determines transfer admission based upon the following criteria:

A. Less than 24 credits of transferable credits, as determined by UMUC.

1. Official high school transcript is required.
2. Transcripts from all colleges attended.

B. 24 or more transferable credits, as determined by UMUC.

1. Cumulative GPA must be a minimum of 2.0.
2. Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended must be sent to UMUC Admissions Office.
3. The minimum grade for credits to transfer is a "C".

MAXIMUM TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

Up to 70 credits may be accepted for transfer credit from 2-year or community colleges.

ON-LINE PROGRAMS

University of Maryland, University College has as its mission to provide higher education opportunities to adult, part-time students. As a result many of their programs are available online or at times to accommodate students who are working full-time jobs.

SELECTION OF TRANSFERABLE CREDITS

Allegany College of Maryland works closely with University of Maryland, University College to advise students in the selection of courses for transfer. Refer to the following resources for information:

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students applying to UMUC for the fall semester should apply between September 1 and March 1, while students applying for the spring semester should apply between September 1 and November 1.

- Send official transcript from each college or university attended. Transcripts should be mailed directly to UMUC from the registrar of each institution.
- Provide a list of courses in progress (if not included on the current school transcript).

- Send official high school transcript and SAT I or ACT results (for applicants with fewer than 24 college level credits).
- Attach nonrefundable application fee (Alliance students will have the fee waived).
- Send final ACM transcript upon completion of any course work in progress.

COMPLETION SCHOLARSHIP

Students who complete associate's degree from a participating Maryland community college are guaranteed admission to UMUC and are eligible for the [Completion Scholarship](#). This scholarship enables students to complete your bachelor's degree program for \$12,000 or less.
