### **TRANSFER ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

University of Pittsburgh Johnstown (UPJ) determines transfer admission based upon the following criteria:

#### **A. Less than 12 credits of transferable credits** (as determined by UPJ)

1. Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended must be sent to FSU Admissions Office.
2. High school transcripts and SAT scores must be sent to UPJ Admissions Office.

#### **B. 12 or more transferable credits** (as determined by UPJ)

Transfer applications are reviewed on the basis of college coursework completed. Transfers are required to have at least a cumulative **2.0** GPA on a 4.0 scale (C average) from all schools previously attended for admission to most programs. A 2.5 or higher GPA is strongly encouraged.

### **MAXIMUM TRANSFERABLE CREDITS**

**No more than 60 credits may be accepted for transfer credit from two-year or community colleges. The UPJ Registrar's Office will select up to 60 credits that best fit the student's major**

### **SELECTION OF TRANSFERABLE CREDITS**

Allegheny College of Maryland works closely with University of Pittsburgh-Johnstown to advise students in the selection of courses for transfer. Refer to the following resources for information:

- The [UPJ Transfer Equivalency System](#) alphabetical lists courses that will transfer to UPJ. The left side columns list the subject, course number, title and credits for the transferring school. On the right side you will find UPJ's equivalent subject, course number, title and transfer credits.
  - Some courses are indicated as "non-equivalent" transfer credit is awarded (ENGLIT 0000 for example). This means that the coursework transfers, but not as a specific UPJ course. Non-Equivalent course credits may be used toward graduation as free electives or to fulfill appropriate general education courses with approval from the Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs. These listings are NOT all inclusive, if a college or course is not listed, transfer equivalencies may not have been established.
- The University provides a **GENERAL** guide for students in planning appropriate courses for transfer to the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown and recommends that a student refer to major requirements in conjunction with this transfer information.
- Courses will be officially evaluated for transfer **ONLY** after a student has completed an application for admission and has provided UPJ with a transcript from their previous institutions. To have your materials evaluated, submit a copy of your official transcript with a course description of all courses to the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown, Registrar's Office.
- ACM Transfer advisors are available in Cumberland Campus Student Success Center and Bedford Campus Student Services Offices\.
- UPJ Admissions Office staff visit the ACM campuses through the school year.

## SUGGESTED GENERAL EDUCATION COURSES

Although each major at UPJ has a specific set of general education requirements, the following is a suggested list of Allegany College of Maryland courses that will satisfy the lower-level general education requirements for most majors of UPJ. This course plan was adopted by UPJ in Fall 2016. If you began college prior to that date, speak with an advisor to determine which plan you should follow. ## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Students are encouraged to apply early. Students transferring in the spring are advised to apply in September and fall transfers are advised to apply between September and December.

All admissions decisions are made on a rolling basis. Under a rolling admissions policy, applications are reviewed as their records become complete. Timely applicants have more opportunities for scholarships and housing.

## **GENERAL TRANSFER INFORMATION**

Only official transcripts, ones sent directly to the UPJ Admissions Office, will be recognized for transfer credit.

UPJ only recognizes credits earned at regionally accredited institutions. Allegany College of Maryland is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools.

UPJ will review transcripts and send students a course-by-course evaluation at the time of admission. Each course is evaluated separately. The evaluation includes a review of the description, semester hours, and grade of each course along with the applicability of the course to the student's major at UPJ.

## **MAJOR COURSE REQUIREMENTS**

1. Check the UPJ academic catalog or website to obtain a complete list of courses required by each major.
2. Consult with your advisor, the [Student Success Center](#), or Bedford Campus Student Services Office for course transferability information or appropriate courses for a major.
3. A "C" grade or better is required for a course to transfer.
