# So Your Student's Considering ACM...

### Here's what you need to know!

- Tuition & Fees per year:
  - In-County Residents (Allegany County, MD): \$4,912
  - Out-of-County Residents (Maryland): \$8,452
  - Out-of-State Residents: \$10.462
  - \*Note: Student Housing is a separate cost
- Complete the FREE Admissions Application
- Complete the FAFSA
  - Available online as early as October 1st of your student's senior year: https://studentaid.gov
- Scholarship Application opens November
   1st with monthly deadlines through August
- Paying for Textbooks
  - Can be purchased online or on campus
  - Financial Aid can often help cover costs
- Meal Options
  - Café open Monday-Friday (8:00 am 2:30 pm)
  - On-campus apartments include a full kitchen
  - Standard off-campus options available
- 30+ student clubs & organizations on campus
- Academic Access & Disability Resources available
  - In-class and testing accommodations available
  - Previous IEP and 504 plan recipients encouraged to apply
  - \*Note: Virtual meetings available
- Parking available at no additional cost for all students
- Transportation options:
  - ACM Shuttle to downtown Cumberland, Monday – Friday (one pick-up & drop-off per day)
  - Public transportation pick-up & drop-off on campus
  - Sign-up for weekly trips to Wal-Mart & the local mall
     \*Note: Student Housing residents only
- 24/7 Security & Staff at Willowbrook Woods (Student Housing)



#### ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST:

- Submit online ACM Application for admission
- □ Apply for financial aid (FAFSA) Opens Oct. 1st
- After acceptance, set-up & check your ACM student email regularly
- ☐ Complete online ACM Scholarship Application
- Request that final high school transcript/GED certificate be sent to the Admissions Office
- Apply for Student Housing (if interested in living on-campus)
- Meet with an Academic Advisor (virtual options available)
- ☐ Schedule Placement Test (discuss with Advising Center prior to scheduling)
- Make payment arrangements with Business Office to avoid deregistration
- Attend New Student Orientation
- Purchase textbooks
